The complex nose exhibits black cherry, cocoa powder, cedar and spice nuances. A full-bodied wine with an exceptional fruit to tannin balance, it finishes with berry fruit, cedar and a touch of spice.

Terroir:

Vineyards and sources additional grapes primarily from the Paso Robles viticultural area, which is ideally situated for growing premium varietal wine grapes. Nestled slightly inland, the warm, clear days are insulated from clouds, fog, and severe winds so sufficient heat reaches the grapes. Following sunset, a marine layer moves over the region and cools temperatures approximately 50 degrees, providing conditions conducive to maintaining outstanding acid structure and overall balance.





Vinification:

Aged in a combination of new and used French and American oak barrels for 20-24 months.

Variety: Cabernet Sauvignon 100%

Residual sugar: 7 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 17°C. This rich, mouth-filling wine matches well with beef, lamb, game meats and hard cheeses and will enhance a hearty stew or roast.
