Terroir:

The Arton Domaine of 50 hectares lies on the plateau of Lectoure, in the heart of Gascony. The plateau from which the town of Lectoure emerges is rich in limestone. This is what is called 'porous limestone' and also goes under the name of 'peyrusquet' (pocket of limestone rock), the ideal soil to grow mineral rich complex vines.



Variety: Gros manseng 100%

Residual Sugar: 35 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 12°C. Ideal accompaniment for melon prosciutto, foie gras, ham and desserts.
