This sweet late crop wine made from a blend of Gros Manseng and Petit Manseng grapes is aged in oak vats. It has all the typically light character of the wines from the Domaine d'Arton, and offers us notes of preserved fruits, vanilla and roasted coffee.

Terroir:

The Arton Domaine of 50 hectares lies on the plateau of Lectoure, in the heart of Gascony. The plateau from which the town of Lectoure emerges is rich in limestone. This is what is called 'porous limestone' and also goes under the name of 'peyrusquet' (pocket of limestone rock), the ideal soil to grow mineral rich complex vines.



Variety: Gros manseng 50%, Petit manseng 50%

Residual Sugar: 80 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 12°C. Ideal accompaniment for foie gras and desserts.
