Beautiful yellow colour with tones of gold and green. It is an intense and at the same time elegant. In the nose notes such as wet grass open the way to fruity ones: banana, melon and pineapple, with hints of vanilla. The herbal is endorsed, some menthol sensation, also rich; There is a touch of toast too. From medium to longer finish, with fruity aftertaste.

Terroir:

Traversa wine history began in 1904. When Carlos Domingo Traversa, the son of an Italian immigrant, arrived in Uruguay. His dream – to own family winery started to come true in 1937. Together with his wife purchased 5 hectares of land near Montevideo and started to grow grapes for wine production. In 1956 he founded the cellar with his children, Dante, Luis and Armando.

Currently Traversa family vineyards occupy 380 hectares Canelones wine region and close to the port of Montevideo.

Since the year 2014 our winery has generated 75% of the energy used in its facilities from renewable sources through solar panels.



Vinification:

Aged for 4 months in new French oak.

Variety: Chardonnay 100%

Residual sugar: 2 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 8-10°C. Ideal with rich fish like salmon, tuna. Perfect accompaniment for shrimp and lobster or fruit and cheese plate.
