Georgian Winery that has been first in Canada

Saperavi demonstrates the best qualities of this particular vine. The wine is pomegranate coloured with complex aroma, in which the tones of currants and cherry match harmoniously with the pleasant tones of oak.

History & Terroir:

The history of the company began in 1533, when King Levan of Kakheti founded the traditional Wine Cellar (marani) in the heart of Kvareli. In 1924, Georgia's Government decided to replace the old cellar with a grape recycling factory "Tsiteli (red) Marani", later known as the "Kindzmarauli" Wine Factory. The company's first Joint Stock Company "Vazis Tsremlebi", now known as Corporation Kindzmarauli, was founded in the basement of the wine factory in 1992.

JSC Corporation Kindzmarauli owns 160 Ha of vineyards throughout Kindzmarauli, Kvareli and Nafareuli. The southern ridge of the Caucasus and the rivers, Duruji and Alazani, create a unique microclimate. The high content of black slates reduces the average crop, but also significantly increases the quality of the wine.



Vinification:

Once the grapes are ripe, the healthy bunches are selectively by hand; this take place at the end of September. Classic fermentation with must until complete fermentation, which is followed by malolactic fermentation and refinement in 400 dal Caucasian oak barrels for 1-2 years.

Variety: Saperavi 100%.

Residual Sugar: 4 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 20°C. Goes well with the dishes of red meat and cheese, the specific aroma of the game is balanced well particularly by the wine.
