Crafted from indigenous Armenian grapes. Harmonious wine with a delicate bouquet of acacia flowers, quince and yellow fruit. Smooth, well-balanced and long-lasting.

Terroir:

Armenia Wine Factory, a family winery planted its first vineyards in 2006 in Armavir, a region in the western part of Armenia, located between Mount Ararat and Mount Aragats. This is the heart of the Ararat plain. Dry continental climate. Vineyards are situated at an altitude of ~1000 m.



Vinification:

Hand harvested. Soft pneumatic pressing with inert gas. 12 hours cold settling. Three weeks alcoholic fermentation at ~15°C in stainless steel tanks.

Variety: Kangoun 100%

Residual sugar: 2 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 12°C. Excellent aperitif. Will shine with variety of different dishes, ideal for seafood and chicken.
