Clean scents of wild berries and black cherry, with hints of white pepper and liquorice reflex. Perfume sweet balsamic with hints of leather and cocoa, with velvety and silky tannins.

Dorian is a literature character created by a great writer Oscar Wilde. Dorian, at the beginning of the novel, is a young man; he is forever young, extraordinarily handsome, fascinating and refined, restless and passionate, sublime and inimitable just like this wine which represents his perfect portrait. Nevertheless this wine, on the contrary from the novel protagonist, ages in an extraordinary way, refines and softens while gaining in complexity, becoming more and more elegant and unique.

Terroir:

The Fornello territory, in the municipality of Ziano Piacentino, is located in the beautiful Val Tidone in the Colli Piacentini, one of the four valleys that characterize the hills of Piacenza, in Emilia Romagna. The vineyards reach a total of 73 hectares, divided into two farms, one wholly-owned with certified organic grapes.





Vinification:

Aging 20% in French Allier barriques for about 3 month.

Variety: Barbera 40%, Bonarda 30%, Pinot Nero 10%, Cabernet Sauvignon 10%, Merlot 10%

Residual Sugar: 10 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 16°C. Perfect accompaniment for pasta with meat sauces, Lassagne and cannelloni.
