Prosecco Brunoro Superiore Millesimato 2017

Terroir:

Treviso province, between the towns of Conegliano and Valdobbiadene; a series of hill chains running from east to west, following one another from the plain to the Pre-Alps, equidistant from the sheltering Dolomites to the north and the Adriatic sea. The production area covers ~18,000 Ha of cultivated land. Vines are only on the sunniest part of the hills at an altitude that goes 50-500 m above the sea level.



Vinification:

Traditional in-white process at controlled temperature. Fast Charmat method according to the disciplinary Prosecco di Valdobbiadene DOCG.

Variety: Glera 100%

Residual sugar: 18 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 7-8°C. Excellent as an aperitif but also very well suited as an accompanying wine for a complete meal.
