Dark ruby colour. Hints of black fruit combine perfectly with the acidity, typical of the Dão's terroir. An authentic wine with complexity, showing the toast from the barrels in harmony with the fruity flavour. A long and persistent finish.

Terroir:

Dão is one of the oldest established wine regions of Portugal, located just south of the famous Douro Valley. Vineyards are at ~600 m elevation on granitic soils with large schist outcrops. Influenced by the rivers Dão and Mondego. There are hot and dry summers and cold winters.





Vinification:

Hand harvested. Total destemming. Fermentation in stainless steel vats with long maceration and soft reassembly. Aged 9 months in new French oak.

Varieties: Touriga Nacional 40%, Alfrocheiro 40%, Tinta Roriz 20%

Residual sugar: 2 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at ~17°C. Pairs perfectly with traditional Portuguese dishes, such as duck rice or roasted veal.
