"This is ridiculously good value from Navarra, the green province set against the Pyrenees adjacent to Rioja. In this wine tempranillo's fresh cherry charm is nicely set amid herbal, slightly meaty, rosemary and oaky notes. It is medium weight, supple, generous and slightly jammy, with soft tannin and some warmth. The focus and length are very good." **Score – 89p (David Lawrason, Wine Align, 2019)**

Crafted from select Tempranillo grapes grown on old vines. Intense with great freshness on the nose and ripe red fruit, wild cherries and strawberries, predominating. Vibrant, rich and full-bodied.

Terroir:

Winery founded in 1958. 600 Ha of vineyards is located in Murchante in the southernmost reaches of Navarra's Ribera Baja region. Some vines more than 50 years old. Region enjoys an extremely positive influence from nearby Mount Moncayo, which regulates the temperature on the right bank of the River Ebro.



Vinification:

The grapes are fermented with their skins for a period of 15 days at maximum temperatures of 25°C.

Variety: Tempranillo 100%

Residual Sugar: 2 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Decant and serve at 14°C with poultry, red meats, stews, cold cuts and cheeses.
