### Brand:

The word "barrister" originates from the word "bar", the barrier that separates the judge from the defendant. Barrister is the highest rank of lawyer in Britain. Since the XV century, the prisoners could instruct "an educated and eloquent friend" to protect their interests. The barristers had access to the "judicial bar", thus they could be heard by the court in the interests of their client. The barrister's speech in court is precise and sharp as a blade.

Brits say that gin is "as cold as steel" - due to the clean, cold aftertaste.

### Production Process:

Aromatic spirits obtained by distillation are blended according to the classic English recipe.

**Aromatic Ingredients:** juniper berry, lemon peel, cardamom, coriander, cinnamon, anis.

**Serving suggestions:** Great with Tonic Water and lots of ice cubes, garnish with orange peel.

- 50 mL Barrister Dry Gin
- 70mL pomegranate juice
- 70mL orange juice
- 60mL sparkling water
- 2 teaspoons honey
- orange slices
- fresh thyme
- Ice
