**Sustainable Farming, Bee Friendly**

*Deep, dark appearance. The very intense nose of black fruit is accentuated by some finely spiced, toasted and oaky notes. The wine is very powerful on entry to the palate with remarkably fine, elegant and well-coated tannins that give it loads of volume. Long-lingering aromatic finish. A rare vintage.*

### Winery & Terroir:

184 wine growers & 95 employees jointly committed to Ecological and Corporate Social Responsibility for >10y. 1,935 Ha vineyards between the Garonne & the Landes forest =95% of AOC Buzet. **900 Ha certified High Environmental Value, 75 Ha Organic.**



### Vinification:

Traditional vinification at moderate temperatures 27°C with gentle pumping over and running off. Macerated ~20 days. Matured in French oak barrels for 15 months.

**Variety:** Merlot 50%, Cabernet Sauvignon 25%, Cabernet Franc 25%

**Residual sugar:** 1.7 g/L

**Serving suggestion and food pairing:** Serve at 17°C. Perfect accompaniment for grilled, stewed or braised meats as well as refined dishes such as filet mignon Rossini (with goose liver, truffles, port and croutons).
