Zakarpattia 5y.o. brandy boasts a complex aroma with hints of dried fruits, figs, dates, tones of vanilla, and roasted nuts, developed over 5 years of aging noble brandy spirits in oak barrels. The aromatic palette unfolds into a rich and balanced taste that lingers.

History and Terroir:

The Chizay winery was founded in 1995 in the town of Beregovo in the Transcarpathian region of Ukraine, in the beautiful Chizay gorge where Ukraine borders with Hungary. 272 Ha of vineyards are located in the Beregovo, Irshava and Mukachevo districts of the Transcarpathian region at the hills of mineral-rich old volcanic mountains.



Vinification:

Noble brandy spirits aged for a minimum of 5 years. Further maturation in 2d use barrels from Chateau Chizay wine.

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve it at a room temperature in a fine sniffer. Focus on the aroma first and then savour the velvety taste. Best enjoyed in the company with friends. Zakarpattia brandy will enhance your evening and serve as an excellent digestif after dinner. Additionally, we recommend indulging in the Zakarpattia tradition of savouring brandy with coffee.
