Brandy Zakarpattia “Mala Hora” has a refined and complex aroma of nuts, chocolate, dried apricots, and elegant vanilla that complement each other in a soft taste. The aftertaste is long with a light tone of roasted nuts.

History and Terroir:

The Chizay winery was founded in 1995 in the town of Beregovo in the Transcarpathian region of Ukraine, in the beautiful Chizay gorge where Ukraine borders with Hungary. 272 Ha of vineyards are located in the Beregovo, Irshava and Mukachevo districts of the Transcarpathian region at the hills of mineral-rich old volcanic mountains.



Vinification:

The harmony of the drink was formed over a long time – an average of 7 years in oak barrels with additional aging in barrels previously used for Chateau Chizay’s signature wines. The age of the oldest cognac spirit in the blend is 17 years.

Serving suggestion and food pairing: at room temperature in a wide bowl sniffer, thoughtfully and with pleasure. Pair with chocolate and dried fruits, nuts and cheese platter. Excellent as a digestif on its own. Best enjoyed during pleasant, unhurried conversations with good friends.
