Red Dry wine Mukuzani is made in the Kakheti region from the Saperavi grape variety grown in the Mukuzani Micro-Zone.

The wine has a flavour traditional to this strain with notes of ripe cherries, almonds, vanilla, and spicy spices. The wine has a velvety taste and a long finish.

Terroir & History:

The “Chelti” winery was founded in 2001 in Kakheti region, village of Shilda, Kvareli district. The winery is surrounded by 50 Ha of vineyards. Chelti is situated in the foothills of the Caucasus Mountains overlooking the fertile Alazani River Valley. The soil composition in the Shilda Village area varies per variety and zone. Saperavi variety vineyards are on sandy gravel soil



Vinification:

Handpicked, 2 harvests, small batch, temperature controlled fermented.

Variety: Saperavi 100%

Residual sugar: 2.0 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 16°C. Perfect accompaniment for red meat dishes and cheese.
