Light straw colour with gold tints emphasizes bright aromas of peach, exotic fruits and citrus hints, light shades of honey and vanilla.

History & Terroir:

Swiss immigrants started winemaking settlement in the village of Shabo, Belgorod-Dnestrovsky district, Odessa region in 1822. Now Shabo Winery has over 1,200 Ha of vineyards between the Black Sea and the Dniester estuary planted with 4 million vines, 30 grape varieties. Shabo crafts most awarded internationally wines and brandies from Ukraine. Mild steppe climate softened with sea and river influence, alluvial brown clay reach soils.





Vinification:

Made from selected grapes grown on special micro-parcels of unique Shabo terroir grape quantity per vine is limited to 1.4 kg. The grape harvested by hand at dawn. Grape bunches after being harvested in compact boxes are delivered within 15 minutes by refrigerators to micro vinification cellar. Without prior crushing, white variety grapes are gently pressed first at Bucher XPlus press machines and then undergo fermentation process in oak barrels.



Residual sugar: 3 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 12°C. Perfect accompaniment for fish, seafood, mid ripen cheeses and poultry.
