The scarlet red colour is characterized by a complex and intense bouquet with notes of sweet fruits – ripe plums and figs – which develop over time. Fine flavours of spices and saffron in the end. Deep and velvety taste reminds of the same fruit flavour with ample hints of delicate tannins and a long sensual aftertaste.

Terroir:

Purcari Wineries Group is a leader in the wine and brandy segments in the Central and Eastern Europe region, managing 1,000 Ha of vineyards and 4 wineries in Romania and Moldova: Purcari, Crama Ceptura, Bostavan and Bardar.

The village of Purcari and the Agon Zograf Monastery vineyards lay at the heart of the special terroir. In 1827, Emperor of Russia Nicholas I issued a special decree granting Purcari the status of the first specialized winery in Bessarabia.

The "Ștefan Vodă" PGI region is one of the 4 wine-growing regions in Moldova, located in the S-E part with 4 districts – Căușeni, Ștefan Vodă, Cimisia and Basarabeasca.



Vinification:

Handpicked, produced by the traditional method. Aged for 18 months in French oak.

Varieties: Cabernet Sauvignon 70%, Saperavi 25%, Rara Neagra 5%

Residual Sugar: 3.5 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Decant for 30 min and serve at 18°C. A complex conversation wine that is serious but approachable, elegant but ripe for drinking tonight while the rest of the case reaches its peak in the cellar. Perfect accompaniment for noble ripened cheeses beef, lamb or mutton.
