Ruby red colour; Notes of cherry and strawberry, fresh, balanced and pleasantly lively, slightly tannin, good body and soft structure.

Terroir:

The vineyards and winery are in beautiful Nizza Monferrato, where the rolling hills of Monferrato meet the rugged hills of the Langhe.

Monferrato Rosso Bujeu comes from "The Bujeu" vineyards, 240 m elevation. Soil composition: marl, sands and sandstone. 18 y.o. vines.

Barbera del Monferrato, situated in Italy's north-western Piedmont region, is probably the least known of the three Piedmontese classified Barbera zones. It is the largest of the trio.



Vinification:

Handpicked in October. Main part Nebbiolo blended with Barbera. Fermentation in vats at a controller temperature of ~27°C. Aged 6 months in French oak.

Varieties: Nebbiolo 60%, Barbera 40%

Residual Sugar: 1 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 17°C. Perfect accompaniment for fowl and all red meats, game, stews and medium-mature cheeses.
