Terroir:

Viña Vilano lies in **Pedrosa**, a little place well known as a **Grand Cru of the D.O. Ribera del Duero**. The estate has >300 hectares, planted with Tempranillo at >900m elevation on poor sandy-clay soils. Grapes picked from one of the oldest vineyards of the region (~35 y.o. on average), with many vines 100 years and older.





Vinification:

Fermented during 10 days at 28°C and macerated for another 14 days. Aged 14 months in American and French oak barrel and over 24 months in bottles.

Variety: Tempranillo 100%

Residual Sugar: 4 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Decant and serve at 18°C. Perfect accompaniment for the roasted lamb and roasted suckling pig, pork, stewed rabbit, rice dishes, spaghetti Bolognese, aged cheeses.
