Voskevaz Nuraz red dry wine is the perfect marriage of two Armenian grape varieties: Haghtanak and Kakhet. This union unveils a garnet red colour wine with complex aromas of cherries, plums, hints of toasted oak wood and a harmonious taste with smooth tannins. Partly aged in Armenian oak barrels, once opened, this wine develops its whole potential after some time.

History & Terroir:

Voskevaz Nuraz is made from hand harvested local grape varieties grown nearby Dvin-the ancient capital of Armenia and Aghavnatun village.

Voskevaz Winery was established in 1932 and located in Aragatsotn region of Armenia in the village by the same name, "Voskevaz" ("golden bunch" in Armenian). The remains of "Badali Jam" church built in the 5th-7th centuries are just a couple of kilometres away, on the edge of the picturesque gorge of river Kasakh. Parts of karases (Armenian clay amphorae which were dug into the ground and used to ferment & age the wine) were found nearby.



Vinification:

Handpicked grapes. Aged in local Armenian oak barrels for 6 months.

Variety: Haghtanak 70%, Kakhet 30%

Residual sugar: 2 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Decant well and serve at 18°C with grilled red meat, steaks, aged cheese and pasta.
