Areni red dry is a medium bodied wine made from the delicate indigenous Armenian grape variety Areni Noir. This elegant burgundy-red wine reveals a light bouquet of ripe cherries, complex aromas of red fruits and spices, supple tannins and a smooth persistence.

History & Terroir:

Voskevaz Winery was established in 1932 and located in Aragatsotn region of Armenia in the village by the same name, "Voskevaz" ("golden bunch" in Armenian). The remains of "Badali Jam" church built in the 5th-7th centuries are just a couple of kilometres away, on the edge of the picturesque gorge of river Kasakh. Parts of karases (Armenian clay amphorae which were dug into the ground and used to ferment & age the wine) were found nearby.



Vinification:

Handpicked grapes are destemmed and crushed gently in order to avoid skin damage. Aged in stainless steel tanks.

Variety: Areni Noir 100%

Residual sugar: 2 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 18ºC with meat appetizers, soft

cheeses and pasta.
