Intense ruby red. Aromatic notes of wild fruits, very ripe red fruits and jam. Delicate, very soft, fruity with ripe tannins and a long pleasant finish.

## Terroir & History:

The Dão region may be described as a plateau surrounded by several mountain ranges, offering conditions in terms of granitic soil, continental climate and grape varieties like Touriga Nacional and Tinta Roriz. Located in the heart of Portugal it sometimes likened to Portugal's Burgundy. Officially demarcated in 1908, the Dão region is one of the oldest wine regions of Portugal, and it was the religious orders, particularly the monks of the Cistercian Order, that spread the culture of the vineyard during the Middle Ages, which has expanded regularly since then.



## Vinification:

Fermentation in stainless steel tanks at a controlled temperature.

Varieties: Alfrocheiro 30%, Touriga Nacional 30%, Tinta Roriz 40%

Residual sugar: 7 g/L

**Serving suggestion and food pairing:** Serve at 16 °C. Perfect accompaniment for grilled meats, steak and poultry.
