Made from Dornfelder - most cultivated red grape variety in region of Rheinhessen this wine has a soft and light body. Fruity and smooth with a typical taste of dark berries. Lower content of tannins but a very fruity style. Very fruity and easy drinking.

History & Terroir:

Founded 1953, acquired by the Kessler-Zink family in 1989 and grown and developed by 3 generations since then. 100 Ha of the vineyards in the heart of Rheinhessen - Germany's largest region for quality appellation wines. Rheinhessen covers an area south of Rheingau, north of Pfalz and east of Nahe. Rheinhessen is favourably influenced by the Rhine river (which runs along its north and eastern borders), along with the Nahe river to the west and the Haardt mountains to its south that form a natural region border.



Variety: Dornfelder 100 %

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 16°C with grilled meat, pork or beef. Perfect choice for BBQ.
