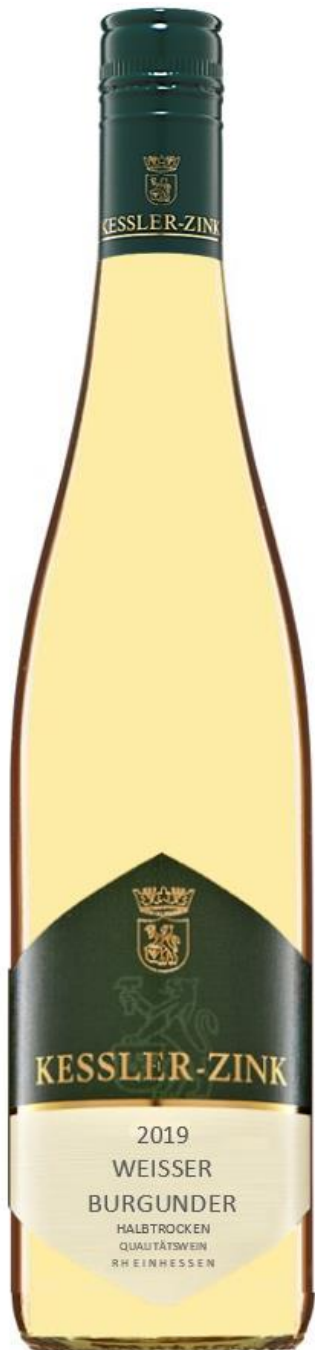

Creamy, fresh and smooth it impresses with intense fruity bouquet. Very mild, light-bodied with notes of grapefruit rind, peach, apricot and cantaloupe. Typical taste of pineapple and a peach with freshness appears by the bubbles on the tongue.

History & Terroir:

Founded 1953, acquired by the Kessler-Zink family in 1989 and grown and developed by 3 generations since then. 100 Ha of the vineyards in the heart of Rheinhessen - Germany's largest region for quality appellation wines. Rheinhessen covers an area south of Rheingau, north of Pfalz and east of Nahe. Rheinhessen is favourably influenced by the Rhine river (which runs along its north and eastern borders), along with the Nahe river to the west and the Haardt mountains to its south that form a natural region border.



Vinification:

Controlled cold fermentation in stainless steel, stopped at 15 gr/L residual sugar.

Varieties: Weisser Burgunder (Pinot Blanc) 90%, Rivaner 10%

Residual Sugar: 13 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 12°C. Perfect accompaniment for roasted duck, asparagus, vegetables with creamy sauce.

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
