History & Terroir:

Founded 1953, acquired by the Kessler-Zink family in 1989 and grown and developed by 3 generations since then. 100 Ha of the vineyards in the heart of Rheinhessen - Germany's largest region for quality appellation wines. Rheinhessen covers an area south of Rheingau, north of Pfalz and east of Nahe. Rheinhessen is favourably influenced by the Rhine river (which runs along its north and eastern borders), along with the Nahe river to the west and the Haardt mountains to its south that form a natural region border.



Vinification:

Controlled cold fermentation in stainless steel.

Varieties: Grauburgunder (Grauer Burgunder, Pinot Gris, Pinot Grigio) 90%, Chardonnay 10%

Residual Sugar: 3 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 10°C. Perfect accompaniment for dishes with roasted meat, deep fried pork or beef.

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
