Deep red, with brown reflexes. Harmonious and soft red wine, with deep structure and smooth in tannins. Delicious flavour of dark red fruits accompanies a blackberry and red cherry notes in the taste. Wine for wine beginners, but also for wine experts who prefer an easy drinking style.

## **History & Terroir:**

Founded 1953, acquired by the Kessler-Zink family in 1989 and grown and developed by 3 generations since then. 100 Ha of the vineyards in the heart of Rheinhessen - Germany's largest region for quality appellation wines. Rheinhessen covers an area south of Rheingau, north of Pfalz and east of Nahe. Rheinhessen is favourably influenced by the Rhine river (which runs along its north and eastern borders), along with the Nahe river to the west and the Haardt mountains to its south that form a natural region border.



Variety: Spätburgunder (Pinot Noir) 100%
