Piemonte Brachetto DOC 2019 Bera Azienda Agricola, Piedmont, Italy





A uniquely bright and fresh red semi-dry light (on alcohol, but not on sensation) sparkling wine, cherry red in colour, with a characteristic fragrance of fresh flowers and roses long with a slight musky sensation and intenseness of red fruits. Sweet, vivid, fresh with pleasant acidity, it explodes on the finish with the same fruity notes felt by the nose.

Terroir:

Bera Azienda Agricola is located in the Langhe, on the right side of the river Tanaro, between Alba and Asti, surrounded by the villages of Barbaresco, Neive, Mango and Treiso in the village Neviglie. Vineyards cover a soft slopes hill with south-southwest orientation following the road from Neive to Neviglie. The soil is light-brown, rich in limestone and friable. A windy spot due to the conformation of the hills 320-380 m altitude.





Vinification:

Fermentation in steel tanks, with controlled temperature. Fermentation is stopped by cooling at desired residual sugar and alcohol level.

Variety: Brachetto 100%

Residual Sugar: 120 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve chilled to 11°C. Perfect accompaniment for wild berries, sweets and strawberry parfait, jam tarts and sweets in general.
